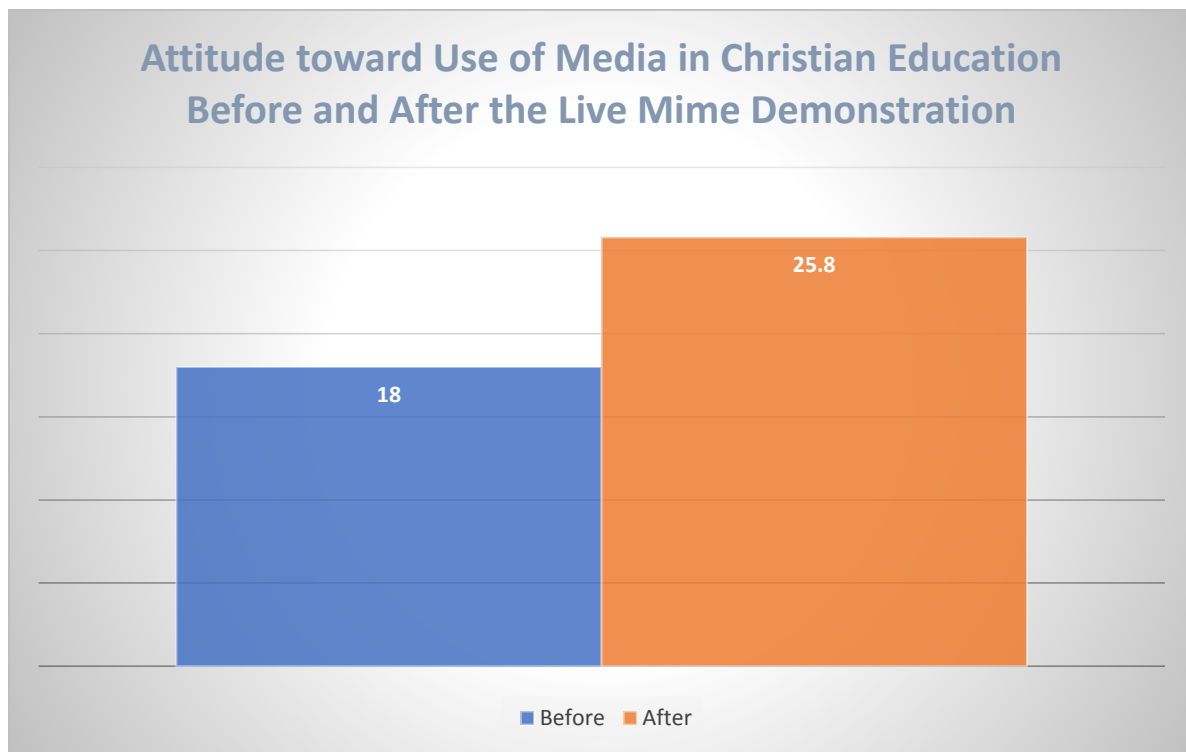


Summary of Results for a Demonstration Requested by the Sixth Mount Zion Missionary Baptist Church and Approved by the Allegheny Union Baptist Association (AUBA)

Of the 35 participants who represented 15 different Baptist churches in Western Pennsylvania:

- Nearly 70% became more positive in their attitude toward use of media in Christian Education.
- The average gain from Before to After the mime was 7.8 points (graph).
- The average age for participants was 66.8.
- The average number of grades completed for participants was 14.8.
- Females were 79.2% of those participants who completed our inventory.

In future applications we will examine the extent to which age, education, and gender play a role in participants' attitude toward use of media in Christian Education.
